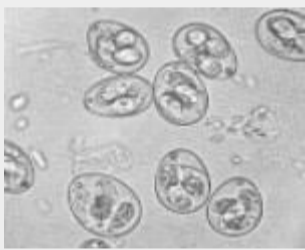
Mycoplasmosis
