Abortion in Ewes

An abortion rate in excess of two per cent is suggestive of an infectious cause and veterinary investigation is essential at an early stage.



Ram Disease Pre- and Post-Sale

As a consequence of high concentrate feeding often in preparation for sale, rams are prone to several conditions.



Ram Management

Although the breeding period on many intensive sheep farming enterprises may only extend to five or six weeks, effective management of rams necessitates all year round attention.



Mating for Early Lambing

The onset of the breeding season can be manipulated by:

- The ram effect
- Melatonin implant
- PMSG injections following progesterone sponges



Final Assure Ewe
