Infection is more commonly encountered in beef cows grazing poor wet pasture....



**Consider targeted parasite control** throughout grazing season.....



**Don't ignore** the threat of lungworm.....



**Prepare for sheep** parasite control in the season ahead...



**Nematodiosis in Sheep**  
A parasitic infection which causes profuse scour in lamb grazed on pasture in consecutive years....



### RELATED PARASITE DISEASES



#### PGE and lungworm in cattle

Present on many farms and can cause respiratory distress and coughing in young or previously unexposed cattle....



#### Gastrointestinal Nematode Infestations in Sheep

Perhaps the most important group of conditions limiting intensive sheep enterprises....



#### Liver fluke control in sheep:

Liver fluke infestation (fasciolosis) has always been a problem during the late autumn and winter in the wetter western areas of the UK.....
