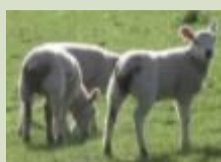

Multiple resistance to anthelmintics has been reported throughout the UK.....



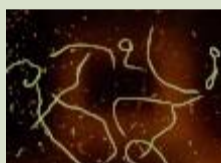
